
School and children's news

Please remember that children need to bring suitable clothing for their Forest Schools sessions. They need their arms and legs covered with long sleeves and trousers/leggings to protect from scratches, nettle stings etc. It is fine for these clothes to be thin in the hotter weather but bare arms and legs are not suitable. They also need suitable closed-in footwear (not sandals). Children can come to school wearing their Forest Schools clothing, or in hotter weather they may prefer to bring it in and change later.
