#### **Attendance**

This week's whole-school attendance was 92.6%. The top three classes were:

- 1. Rowling Class 96%
- 2. McKee Class 95%
- 3. Lewis Class 94.3%

The highest attending class each week wins extra playtime or another activity chosen by the class. Please remember that the school is required to refer children who have 10 or more sessions of unauthorised absence to the Education Welfare Officer, and that each school day has two sessions.



#### Safety reminders

#### Cycle helmets

Please remember that we only allow children to store their bikes in school if they are wearing an appropriate helmet. If your child is riding a bike to school without a helmet, we will <u>not</u> be allowing them to bring it into the school grounds.

#### Sun protection, hot weather and summer clothing/footwear

Although the weather is not yet as not as last summer's extreme temperatures, we do still need to be careful about wellbeing and safety in the sun and warm weather. We have seen a surprising number of children without a water bottle this week, which is worrying.

Make sure your child has:

- Water bottle (they can refill these as needed throughout the day)
- Sun hat or cap
- Sun cream (please see the policy for details of what is needed and what school will be able to help with)

Please make sure that **summer sandals** are safe, sensible and suitable for active play and walking across different surfaces (e.g. steps, playgrounds, grass, bark chips, carpet, gravel and concrete). Unsecured sandals, sliders or flip flops, or any shoe that does not hold the foot securely are not acceptable. Sandals should have a secure ankle strap and adequate strapping across the foot.







#### School and children's news

Arabella S-B has achieved her Stage 2 Learn To Swim award – well done, Arabella!

Well done to the various children from Year 6 who undertook and passed their Level 1 and 2 Bikeability courses over the last few weeks. Bikeability is the government's national cycle training programme (we used to call it 'cycling proficiency'). It helps children learn practical skills and understand how to cycle on today's roads. Bikeability gives everyone the confidence to cycle and enjoy this skill for life.

Year 6 are performing their show 'The Island That Rocks' for parents and carers on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July at 13:35 and 17:15. Details of how to get tickets will follow. Children in Years 3-5 have the opportunity to join the chorus and perform if they wish to, but this is primarily a Year 6 event and children will be a bigger part of a show as they reach the oldest class each year.

#### Relationships and Sex Education

Relationships and Sex Education are a statutory part of the National Curriculum. Parents do <u>not</u> have the right to withdraw their children from Relationships Education as all aspects of RSE which address objectives from the National Curriculum for Science are compulsory for all pupils. However, we realise some parents may have questions or worries about what will be covered. Please look at the curriculum map at the very end of the policy for more details, and do talk to Ms Judd (Year 4) or Mrs Cooper and Mrs Sheppard (Year 6) if you have any queries.

Parents have the right to withdraw their children only from the non-statutory components of Sex Education within RSE; these non-statutory elements are highlighted on the RSE curriculum map in Appendix 1 (NB: the only content that is non-statutory is the Year 6 module 'Making Babies'). Parents of children in Year 6 wishing to withdraw their child from these lessons must complete/adhere to the following:

- Read the policy, the schemes of work and review used resources
- Discuss concerns with a member of the school's Senior Leadership Team

If parents/carers still wish to withdraw their child after the steps above have been taken, they will be asked to put their request in writing to the Headteacher. Pupils who are withdrawn are expected to attend school as usual; they will be accommodated in another classroom or area of the school during the withdrawn session.

Please be aware that the content being covered across the school is no different to what has been taught at Frogwell for at least the last ten years; the only change was that is became statutory for all schools in 2020.
