#### **World Autism Acceptance Week**

Monday 27 March to Sunday 2 April 2023 is World Autism Acceptance Week. Autism is a spectrum condition and it affects people in different ways. Like all people, autistic people have their own strengths and weaknesses. Two of the key difficulties faced by autistic people are:

- Social communication autistic people have difficulties with interpreting both verbal and non-verbal
  language like gestures or tone of voice. Some autistic people are unable to speak or have limited
  speech while other autistic people have very good language skills but struggle to understand sarcasm
  or tone of voice.
- Social interaction autistic people often have difficulty 'reading' other people recognising or understanding others' feelings and intentions and expressing their own emotions. This can make it very hard to navigate the social world. Autistic people may:
  - > appear to be insensitive
  - > seek out time alone when overloaded by other people
  - > not seek comfort from other people
  - appear to behave 'strangely' or in a way thought to be socially inappropriate
  - > find it hard to form friendships.
