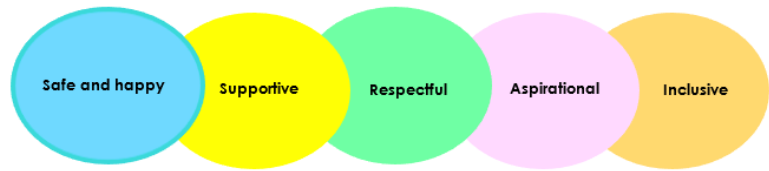

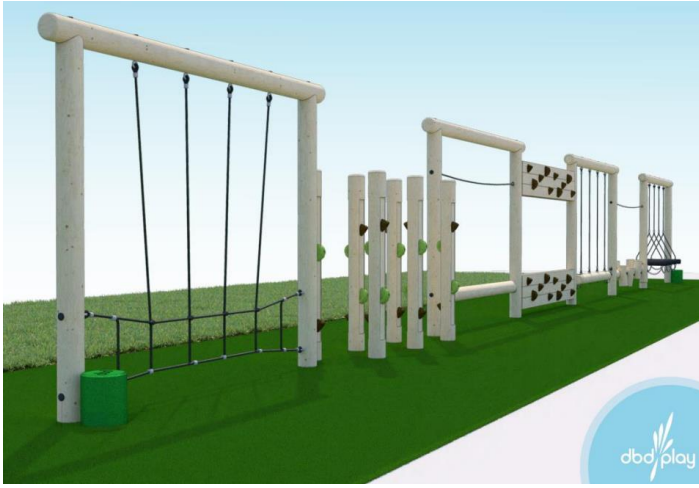
Multiskills Festival

Reminders
