Parent/Carer Consultation Evenings

Parent/Carer Consultation Evenings are next week on Monday 10th October (15.30-17.30) and Thursday 13th October (16.00-18.30). Unfortunately, we have had to postpone Morpurgo Class appointments because Mrs Andrews is unable to return to school at the moment. If you have not yet booked an appointment slot, please do sign up; contact the school office if you need help with this.

Parents will need to enter the site through the small playground gate and then come into the building via the door near the hall (turn right immediately after the climbing wall once you have come through the gate!). All the teachers <u>except</u> Mrs Jenkins (Donaldson Class) and Mrs Gumbrill (Potter Class) will be in their usual classrooms; Mrs Jenkins will be in The Den (opposite the hall) and Mrs Gumbrill will be in the Music Room (next door to Year 6). There will be a sign to point you in the right direction!

There will also be tea, coffee and biscuits in the corridor area near the Year 3 and 4 classes where you can talk to Ms Neville (Headteacher) and Mr Filer (SENCo).

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New play trail

As you will hopefully have seen in my email earlier this week, we are having a brand-new play trail installed next week. Normally we would try to do this type of project during school holidays, but the company had no holiday-time availability for several months and we want the children to enjoy this new facility so have risk assessed doing it during school time. Plans are in place to ensure it can be done safely with children and staff on site. It is essential, though, that all children and adults stay well away from the construction area, which will be barriered off throughout. The construction crew will be on site from 07.30 until the evening each day, so it critical that you keep your children close by you at drop off and pick times, and that all children keep away from the work area during the school day. We are really looking forward to having this lovely new equipment in school. Thank you in advance for your support to help us ensure it can be installed safely.
