School news

Parents' Evenings

Parents' Evenings will be held on Monday 10th October (15.30-17.30) and Thursday 13th October (16.00-18.30), and then again in the Spring. These will be face-to-face short appointments, but you will be able to request a Teams or phone appointment if you cannot attend in person. These meetings will be focused mainly on how your child has settled into their new class, how they are getting on and any ways we need you to support at home. Booking is online and you should have received details of how to do this – please contact the school office if you have any difficulties with booking. Please note that where parents are separated, it is expected that they will share one appointment slot except for the very small number of families where there is a very strong welfare-related reason, such as a court order, preventing it.

Harvest collection

We will be holding our usual Harvest assembly later this term and would like to ask for donations for Doorway, the local charity that supports people who are homeless or in vulnerable housing situations. There is a flyer at the end of this letter showing the items they need and those which they cannot accept. We have extended the donation drop-off window to <u>Wednesday 5th October</u>.

Toys / fiddly objects in school

We have noticed some problems arising with children bringing toys, teddies, cuddlies etc to school. Although there is a small number of children who have a genuine reason to have an agreed and suitable fidget or comfort item due to a particular need, in general there should not be any toys or teddies coming to school. They are causing a lot of disruption and distraction and are not suitable for school. Where children have a special educational need or disability that requires a fiddle or comfort item, these will have been agreed with the class teacher and/or SENCo and the right type of item chosen. All other toys and teddies now need to stay at home. If any unsanctioned toys do come in, children will be expected to put them away in their bags or in the teacher's cupboard until the end of the day and then to not bring them back the next day. Thank you for your support with this.

Please can **all** parents and carers remember to stay away from the classroom windows. Parents coming up close to look through is distracting to the children. Please stand well back.

Please can everyone remember that there is no parking allowed in the taxi spaces in the car park except for Wiltshire Council school transport taxis. Parking is limited and parents/carers will need to allow time to park up the road and walk along. Cars must not be parked, even with someone waiting inside, in the taxi area.

Please do not smoke around the school entrance areas.

Please drive slowly and carefully in the car park and in the streets around the school, paying attention to pedestrians.
