## The Five Pillars of Islam

As well as the six main beliefs, there are **Five Pillars of Islam**.

Shahadah: Muslims say a declaration of faith.

**Salah:** Muslims pray five times a day. Before prayer, they must wash themselves and then face Mecca whilst praying.

Zakat: Muslims must donate to charities.

**Sawm: Muslims** fast for one month during a time called **Ramadan**.

**Hajj: Muslims** have to travel to **Mecca** once in their lifetime, if they can afford to.

## The Six Main Beliefs

- 1. Belief in Allah as the one and only God.
- 2. Belief in angels.
- 3. Belief in the holy books.
- Belief in the prophets and that Muhammad was the final prophet.
- Belief in the Day of Judgement (the day when Allah decides if a person goes to heaven or hell).
- Belief in predestination (the belief that Allah has already planned out what will happen).
