Cloth Thread



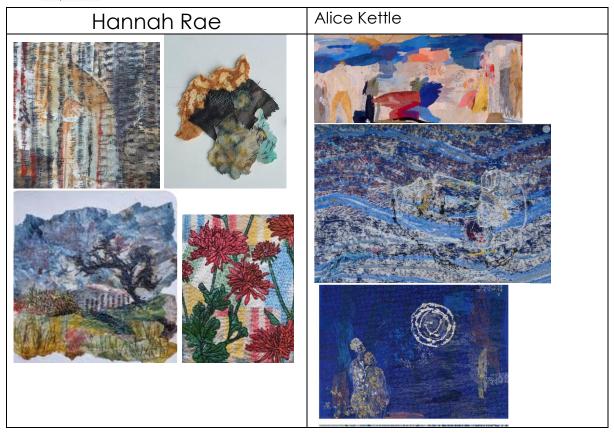
woven or felted fabric made from wool, cotton, or a similar fibre Cotton wool nylon silk are examples of cloth



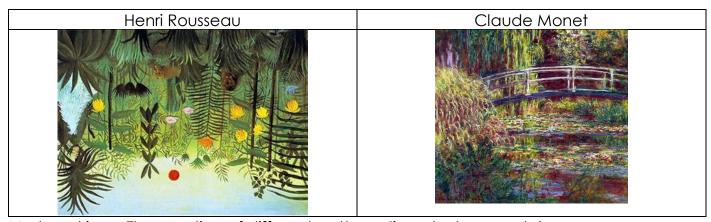
a long, thin <u>strand</u> of cotton, nylon, or other <u>fibres</u> used in sewing or weaving.

We will be looking at two textile artists.

A textile artist is an artist who creates uses cloth and thread.



We will be looking at Claude Monet and Henri Rousseau for inspiration for our own artwork.



Mark-making – The creation of different patterns, lines, textures and shapes. Stitch – A loop of thread that makes a mark with your sewing needle. Canvas – the material you are putting your artwork onto
