

In **English** we'll be working on writing poetry, our model poem will be 'If I were in charge of the world' by Judith Viorst.

We will have daily spelling practise and a spelling tests every Friday.

As a class we'll be reading 'The day the crayons quit' as well as reading a range of stories at class story time every day.

Our **music** lessons will focus on exploring feelings through music and learning a song on glockenspiels.

**R.E.** will be about Islam. We'll be looking at key information about the religion and asking the question: How does praying 5 times a day help Muslims in their lives?

Our **PSHE** lessons will be based on keeping ourselves safe in different situations.

## DAHL CLASS SPRING TERM 1

In **computing** we'll be working with beebots to learn about robotic algorithms as looking at self image and identity through I.T.

Our main **art** topic this term is Expressive Painting. We'll be looking at how different artists use paint in expressive and abstract art, including Charlie French, Vincent Van Gogh and Paul Cezanne.

**Home-learning** will be based on reading regularly, practising weekly spellings and supporting families engage with the week's learning across the curriculum.

Our **science** will be focussed on exploring different types of materials and their uses.

Our **maths** work will be learning about money, and applying addition and subtraction skills to this topic. Then we will focus on multiplication and division.

**P.E** this term will be doing gymnastics. We also have a weekly PE specialist session with 'Up and Under' based on sending and returning.
