Attendance

This week's whole-school attendance was 95.5%, a good improvement from the last two weeks. The top classes were:

1. Dahl Class 98.2%

2. King-Smith Class 97.8%

3. Rowling Class 97.6%

The highest attending class (or classes!) each week wins extra playtime or another activity chosen by the class. We have also introduced a bigger class prize/reward at the end of each term for the class that has the highest attendance overall for that term – last term it was Halls Class who chose some lovely new train set toys for their class as their prize. Who will it be this term? Please remember that the school is required to refer children who have 10 or more sessions of unauthorised absence to the Education Welfare Officer, and that each school day has two sessions. Cold weather

There is a cold weather alert in place for the next few days – if you are concerned about low temperatures, we recommend that children wear layers to school such as a vest / base layer underneath school uniforms. All children should be wearing a suitable coat to school and should expect be to be told to wear it at outdoor playtimes. Sweatshirt / jumpers / hoodies are not the same as a proper coat. Financial assistance is available for cold weather uniform items; please contact the school office if you wish to find out more about this.

Christmas cards

In school we have a system for giving out Christmas cards that makes it manageable (I am sure you can imagine the potential for chaos with close to 200 people trying to give and receive cards!)

- Cards must not start coming into school until Tues 12th December
- All cards must be put in the Christmas postbox for sorting and distribution to classes by our festive helpers not given out directly by children
- All cards must be labelled with the recipient child's name and class / year group (bearing in mind that there might be more than one child with the same name in the same class!)

Children's Christmas crafts

All the children will have made a handmade craft item that will be available for parents / carers to purchase at the Christmas Fair on Saturday 9th December – the idea is that parents buy their own child's item.

Open Classrooms

It was great to see so many families at this term's Open Classrooms on Wednesday. We have now been holding these sessions once per term for a few months, so it would be great to hear any feedback from parents and carers about whether you find them worthwhile. The attendance has been very high in some classes so it seems parents and carers do value the opportunity to look at children's work and classroom displays, but if you have any comments please do speak to your child's teacher or a member of the senior team, or drop school an email.

Yet more PSHE and 'life skills' work has been going on this week with our Walk Safe sessions in Years 1, 3 and 6. All the groups had on-site Walk Safe workshops as part of the Wiltshire Healthy Schools initiative. Year 3 also had practical sessions in small groups where they went out of school to practise their road-crossing skills.
