Dahl Class have just finished a writing unit based on the poem 'If I Were in Charge of the World' by Judith



NSPCC assemblies and workshops


Last week, all classes took part in the **NSPCC's Speak out**, **Stay safe Programme** as part of our PSHE curriculum and to support age-appropriate learning about safeguarding issues. **Speak out**, **Stay safe** is a national programme for children aged 5-11 which aims to help children understand abuse in all its forms and to recognise the signs of abuse. Children were taught to speak out if they are worried, either to a safe adult or Childline on **0800 1111**.

Halls Class health and wellbeing
