Attendance

Current week attendance

The past week has seen a significant amount of illness among pupils and staff so whole-school attendance has been very low. For the academic year to date we are doing very slightly worse than nationally, so we need to aim to raise attendance figures as much as we can.

The top classes were:

1. Donaldson Class 97.3% 2. Halls Class 97% 3. Potter Class 95%

The highest attending class (or classes!) each week wins extra playtime or another activity chosen by the class. We have also introduced a bigger class prize/reward at the end of each term for the class that has the highest attendance overall for that term – last term it was King-Smith Class. Who will it be this term? Please remember that the school is required to refer children who have 10 or more sessions of unauthorised absence to the Education Welfare Officer, and that each school day has two sessions. Driving and parking on and around school site

You may have seen the local police and PCSOs visiting school around drop off and pick up times this week. School has requested support from the police because we are so concerned about some of the unsafe and inconsiderate driving and parking we are seeing both in the car park area and on Derriads Lane. This has included speeding through the car park, parking on double yellow lines or up on curbs, parking in places that block the flow of traffic or impede visibility. I need the whole community to remember that parking or driving in these ways **puts children's safety at risk**. I am aware that many, many of you are rightly fed up of seeing this type of behaviour; we need to work together to help it stop – obviously in ways that are polite and respectful at all times. I will continue to involve the police with any incidents as needed. Thank you in advance for your support with this.
