HISTORY– Tutankhamun

Who was the boy behind the golden mask?

This term, we will explore the significance of the discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb, in 1922. We will look at the many artefacts found in the tomb and consider what these tell us about Tutankhamun and the ancient Egyptian's beliefs about the Afterlife.

By the end of the unit, children will be able to describe and explain the most likely cause of Tutankhamun's death at just eighteen years of age, and make and justify a judgement as to the most plausible explanation.

MATHS

Fractions and decimals, including:

MUSIC

This term, we will learn about different genres of music; learning to play the Glockenspiel and improvise to the songs.

SCIENCE- Electricity

This term, we will be identifying the sources and consumers of electricity; sorting these using a Venn diagram. We will consider the dangers, and safety precautions that must be taken, when handling electrical appliances and working with electricity. Later in the unit, the children will build their own electrical circuits using a number of components, representing these through scientific diagrams.

COMPUTING – Photo Editing

Lewis Class will learn to manipulate photo images using a range of editing and retouching tools. We will consider why people may choose to retouch images, and the positive and negative effects that retouching can have. Children will create their own fake images and reflect on how easy it is to digitally alter images, and what this might mean for the images that they see around them. composition.

RE - Is forgiveness always possible for Christians?

This term, we are learning about the concept of Salvation and considering what Jesus' life, death and resurrection teaches Christians about forgiveness.
