This is a map of Borneo (third largest island in the world). It is made up of different countries. Can you find the country of Brunei on this map?

Borneo is in the continent of Asia.

Kampong Ayer is a settlement in Brunei. It is close to the equator and it has a tropical climate which means there is a lot of rain even though it is warm.





There are 7 continents in the world. Europe, Africa, Asia, Oceania, Antarctica, North America and South America. We live in the continent of Europe.

This is a house in Kampong Ayer. Kampong Ayer is a settlement in Bandar Seri Begawan, the capital of Brunei. It means 'water village'. Kampong Ayer consists of traditional stilt houses built on the Brunei River.

Kampong Ayer is built in the middle of a wide river. In fact, it is the largest water village in the world. Approximately 30,000 people live there in about 4000 houses. Strong winds can often cause large waves on the river. Very heavy rain storms are another problem that Kampong Ayer has to cope with.
