Literacy & Language/Communication skills:

Science (UTW):

- Daily weather calendar
- Name different types of weather/seasons (daily)
- Spotting signs of spring and growth (plants)
- Making observations of plants and flowers
- Recognising parts of a plant
- Handling/observing seeds.
- Growing cress experiment- conditions for life.
- Planting a seed and taking care of it over time.
- Observing/recording plant growth
- Learning about the life cycle of a plant

Physical Development:

- Weekly PE sessions, Manipulation and coordination focus.
- Weekly swimming session
- Using bikes, trikes & large outdoor equipment
- Fine & Gross motor skills activities.
- Letter formation.
- Independent dressing skills/managing clothing,
