

In **English** we'll be working on story writing based on 'Stardust' by Jeanne Willis and we'll be writing non-fiction reports on big cats. We will have **daily phonics** focussing on revision of phase 5 sounds and spelling practise of high frequency words.

In **history** we're going to learn about how schools have changed over time and how schools were different at different times in the past.

In **computing** we'll learning about computing systems and networks

Our **PSHE** lessons will start by looking at the school values and class rules and then discuss our relationships.

Our **music** lessons will explore simple patterns of music based on songs by Tony Chestnut

As a class we will be **reading** *Traction Man* by Mini Grey and *The Magic Paintbrush* by Julia Donaldson.

Jeffer's Class AUTUMN TERM

Home-learning will be focussed on making sure children read at home and practise some of their learning.

We'll be doing some **art** based on our big cats writing

R.E. will focus Christianity and the question: *Is it possible to be kind to everyone all the time?*

Our **science** will be focussed on exploring animals and humans: We'll consider how animals and humans grow and what we need to be healthy.

This term we'll be developing co-ordination and 'send and return' skills in **P.E**

Maths learning will be based on place value: counting and writing numbers up to 100, representing tens and ones in different models and adding and subtracting one- and two-digit numbers.
