

How do artists use nature to inspire art?

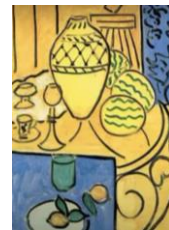
We will look at how two different arts make art using or inspired by **nature**. We will use three different **mediums** and **techniques** to create work inspired by nature and the artists' work.



James Brunt is a contemporary artist who makes **land art**, by observing and creating patterns in nature.

Henri Matisse (1869 – 1954) was a French artist who use collage and **contour line drawings** to represent nature.



We will create:



land art by creating patterns using nature and photograph them using our **digital photography** skills

Contour line drawings of autumn leaves or twigs

Continuous line drawings of natural objects

Wax resist autumn leaves based on Rosie James' technique
