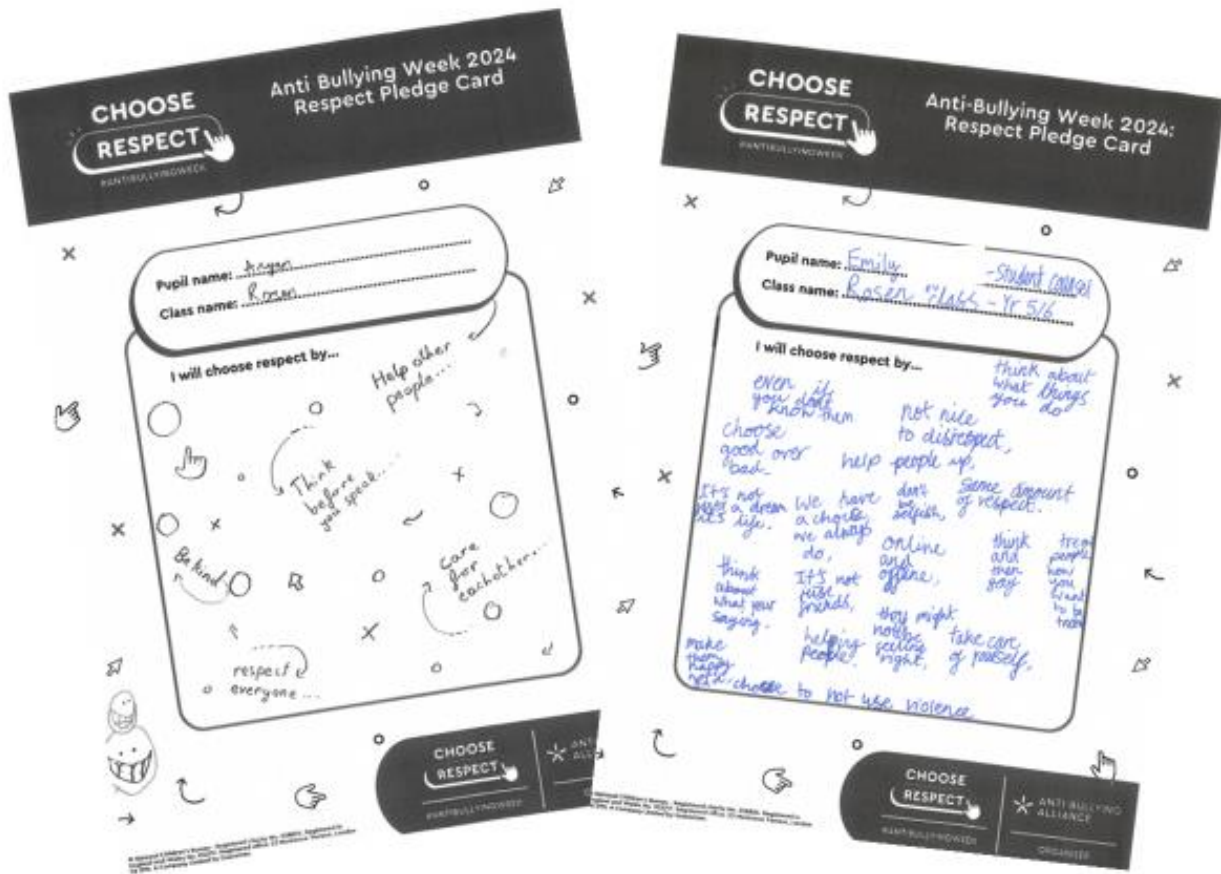
Children In Need
