

In **English** we'll be working on writing fiction based on the poem 'If I were in charge of the world' by Judith Viorst. We'll also be writing stories based on the traditional tale 'The Crow's Tale.'



For **home-learning** children should read as often as possible. Weekly home learning tasks will be uploaded on Fridays and will be designed to consolidate learning and help parents to engage with what children are doing at school.

Daily **spelling** will be based on a weekly spelling list as well as daily practise of the first 100 high frequency words, which the children have a personalised list of.

We will have 4 x weekly group **reading** using phased books and weekly whole class reading practice reading 'The day the crayons quit' by Oliver Jeffers and Amazing Grace.

We also enjoy a **class story** every day.

JEFFERS CLASS Spring Term 1

R.E. will be about Islam. We'll be asking the question: How does praying 5 times a day help Muslims in their lives?



In **history** lessons we'll be exploring the question: How did humans learn to fly?

Our **PSHE** lessons will be based on keeping ourselves safe in different situations.



In **computing** we'll be exploring self image and identity online.



This term we'll be working on gymnastics in **P.E.** and we will be practising games to hone send and return skills.



Our **science** will be focussed on exploring materials and their properties and uses.

Our **music** lessons will continue with composing music based on bird song and we'll then work on listening to and creating a rap.

In **maths** We'll be continuing with our 'mastering number' scheme. Using White Rose, we will be consolidating our learning about 2d and 3d shapes, learning about money and then move on to focus on multiplication and division.



We'll be celebrating **world book week** and continue to enjoy reading for pleasure every day at school.



Our main **art** topic this term is Expressive Painting. We'll be looking at how different artists use paint in expressive and abstract art, including Charlie French, Vincent Van Gogh and Paul Cezanne.
