Key vocabulary	
eternal	lasting or existing forever; without end.
eternity	infinite or unending time:
agape	universal and unconditional love, such as the love for strangers, nature, or God.
Messiah	a saviour from God prophesied about in the Old Testament and Jewish Scriptures.
Unconditional love	love that doesn't expect anything from the other person
New Testament	The part of the Bible with Jesus' teaching
parable	A story used to illustrate a moral or lesson, as told by Jesus in the New Testament

Core Knowledge:

Christians believe that God's love for humankind is eternal in that God will never stop loving humanity. Even if they do wrong, they can say sorry and God will forgive them because he loves them.

Jesus portrayed love in the Bible; He taught that love should be eternal and unconditional. The resurrection of Jesus is the Christian belief that all Christians will also obtain eternal life.

Christians believe that God's love for humankind is eternal in that God will never stop loving humanity. Even if they do wrong, they can say sorry and God will forgive them because he loves them. Christians believe that for eternal life they need to: believe in God, do their best to follow the Ten Commandments and ask for forgiveness when they need it.
