MATHS

We will continue to explore decimals this term, consolidating our learning so far before moving on to money. In this module, we will convert between pounds and pence, compare and order amounts of money, estimate and use our skills to solve problems. Next, we will move on to time where the children will learn to read analogue and digital clocks and convert to and from the 24hr clock.

COMPUTING – Project Evolve

Online Bullying and Reputation

Children will learn to recognise online bullying and the ways that it could be different to in the physical world. Consider how different content posted online could affect others but also their own online reputation.

Finally, children will learn how to identify and access support from trusted adults.

RE – Pilgrimage

The children will learn what pilgrimage means and explore why people of different faiths choose to go on a journey to a holy place. They will discuss whether a pilgrimage is necessary to feel close to God and consider different viewpoints. Children will also learn why pilgrimage is important in a range of religions and what believers gain from the experience. They will explore how going on pilgrimage can impact a person's life and their community.

Music

This term, Lewis Class will be considering how music shapes our way of life. We will listen to a range of musical genres, including: gospel, modern gospel, classical and plainchant (medieval period).

PSHE – Doing My Best

We will learn to recognise that everyone is unique and that there are times that we may make the same choice as our friends but also times when we must choose differently. We will then learn about what our bodies need to be healthy, designing our own healthy menu. Finally, we will learn about ways that we can care for the environment.

The children will learn to name a variety of ice cream flavours and practise using key vocabulary to order an ice cream in French. They will revisit numbers and develop their speaking and listening skills through simple conversations. Children will also learn to use the correct article 'un' or 'une' with nouns and apply this in short spoken and written phrases.
