Key Vocabulary

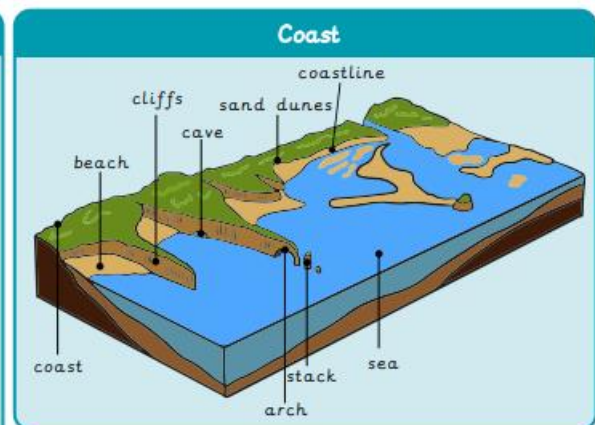
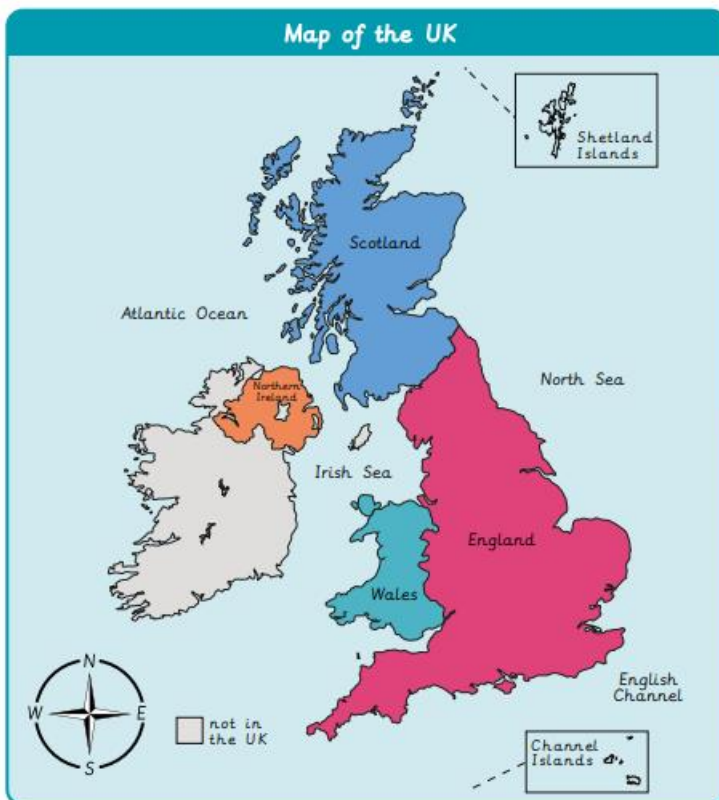
| | |

| Location | A place or position |
| Coast / coastline | Where the land meets the sea |
| Sea | Smaller body of water e.g. North Sea |
| Ocean | Large body of water e.g. Atlantic Ocean |
| Country | Land or nation with its own government |
| Continent | A large land mass, usually made up of several countries |
| Aerial photograph | A photograph taken from the air. |
| Physical feature | A landform which occurs naturally e.g. <i>a beach</i> |
| Human feature | A large feature built by humans e.g. <i>a shop</i> |
| Harbour | A sheltered area for boats |
| Pier | A structure (building) over water |
| Tourist | A person who goes to visit a different place |
