### Year 4's - Multiplication Times Tables Check

A massive well done to our Year 4 pupils, who have started their national Multiplication Times Tables Check (MTC). This week marked the first of a two-week process during which all Year 4 children complete a series of times tables challenges. We have worked hard throughout the year using a range of quizzes, checks and challenges to ensure that the children are fully prepared and able to do their very best.

We know that having a secure knowledge of all multiplication facts up to  $12 \times 12$  will help children access the more complex mathematics they will encounter in Years 5 and 6 with greater confidence.

I would like to take this opportunity to commend Miss Bates for her organised and professional approach to administering these assessments, and to her class, who have been so calm and have impressed me greatly with their positive attitude towards learning.

### Building plans

Our building plans continue to progress. This week, Mr Pierce and I met with the landscape architect on site. He was extremely receptive to our ideas and, if we can deliver them within the allocated budget, the plans will create a range of exciting spaces for children to learn, explore and play.

### Safeguarding visit

Mrs Cooper, our Safeguarding Lead, continues to do a tremendous job overseeing our safeguarding team.

This week, we were audited as part of our Local Authority safeguarding review programme. During a visit from one of the Local Authority's Safeguarding Advisers, our processes, policies and practices were thoroughly reviewed.

I am delighted to report that all areas were judged to be strong and that every action identified during our previous visit in September has been fully addressed.

It is important to us that children and families know that every member of staff receives safeguarding training. In addition, we have a dedicated Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) team:

The DSL team and all staff receive regular safeguarding updates and specialist training in areas including FGM, cyber security, online safety and Prevent.

I am proud to say that our entire staff team is exceptionally well placed to ensure that all children remain “safe and happy”.
