### **Attendance**

This week's whole-school attendance was 96%. The top classes were:

The highest attending class (or classes!) each week wins extra playtime or another activity chosen by the class. We will also be introducing a bigger class prize/reward at the end of each term for the class that has the highest attendance overall for that term! Please remember that the school is required to refer children who have 10 or more sessions of unauthorised absence to the Education Welfare Officer, and that each school day has two sessions. ### Parents' evenings

Parents' Evenings will be held on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October (16.00-18.30) and Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> October (15.30-17.30), and then again in the Spring. Lots of people have already booked their slots! These will be face-to-face short appointments, but you will be able to request a Teams or phone appointment if you cannot attend in person. These meetings will be focused mainly on how your child has settled into their new class, how they are getting on and any ways we need you to support at home. Online booking information will follow from the office in due course. Please note that where parents are separated, it is expected that they will share one appointment slot except for the very small number of families where there is a very strong welfare-related reason, such as a court order or non-molestation order, preventing it.

There will also be a pop-up uniform shop by Chippenham Uniform Exchange at the Wednesday parents' evening, where you can purchase pre-owned uniform items at very low cost.



### **Open Classrooms**

We will be holding an Open Classrooms session on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> October from 15.15 until 15.40. This is a chance for parents and carers to visit their child's classroom with them and have a look at the work they have been doing. We will be holding Open Classrooms once a term and for Term 2 it will be on Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> November.

### **School dinners**

We are finding that some children do not like the school dinner option they have been booked in for. It would really help us if parents could involve children in choosing their meals when booking because we do not want them to go hungry if they refuse the booked meal.
