Attendance and punctuality

Current week attendance

This week's whole-school attendance was 95.2% which is a great increase from last week! The top classes were:

- 1. Donaldson Class 100% (that's 100% 2 weeks in a row for this class!)
- 2. Halls Class 99.1%
- 3. McKee Class 97.5%

The highest attending class (or classes!) each week wins extra playtime or another activity chosen by the class. We have also introduced a bigger class prize/reward at the end of each term for the class that has the highest attendance overall for that term – the winning class for Term 3 overall was **Donaldson Class**, who have chosen a special prize with their teacher. Who will it be this term? Please remember that the school is required to refer children who have 10 or more sessions of unauthorised absence to the Education Welfare Officer, and that each school day has two sessions. Parent/Carer Consultation Evenings

We are holding our Spring Parent/Carer Consultation Evenings on Monday 25th March (15.30-17.30) and Wednesday 27th March (16.00-18.00). Booking information will be sent out separately by the office. Please be aware that appointment slots are limited and teachers cannot offer multiple appointments for the same child. Where parents are separated, it is expected that they will share one appointment slot except for the very small number of families where there is a very strong welfare-related reason, such as a court order, preventing it.

Dogs on school grounds

Please remember that dogs are not permitted anywhere on the school site, except assistance dogs. <u>This includes dogs being carried</u> as well as those walking. We have our own official visiting dog, Roko, who is risk assessed, carefully planned for and insured but other dogs may not enter the site. This includes the area around the car park and along the front of the school, not just in the playground. We also cannot have dogs tied up outside so any dog owners will need to make other arrangements for their animals during school drop off and pick up times.

Emergency Awareness Training

In last week's newsletter I let you know that all our classes would be having emergency awareness and first aid training workshops with the Wiltshire Air Ambulance as part of our ongoing curriculum offer for PSHE and personal development. These sessions took place yesterday and today and it has been amazing to see the children learning such important and potentially life-saving skills and knowledge. The content has varied to suit the age of the class, but has included the recovery position, choking, CPR and defibrillator use, dressings, how to call an ambulance and how to stay safe as a first aid responder. It has been wonderful to see children of all ages gaining confidence and participating. Please look out for your child's certificate and talk to them about what they have learnt. A huge thank you to the Wiltshire Air Ambulance for providing these workshops. You may not know that the WAA (a registered charity) receives no regular direct funding from the Government or National Lottery grants, so relies on the generous donations from the public and local businesses to raise the vital funds needed. It costs £4.5 million a year to keep the lifesaving service operational, which equates to more than £12,000 per day.
