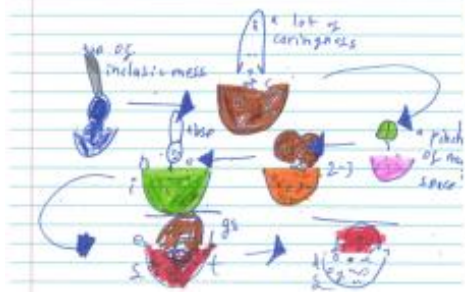
A Recipe For Kindness by Algie May
