


Term 2 - Geography: Would you prefer to live in a hot or cold place?

Key Vocabulary	
Climate	The average long-term weather conditions in a place.
Continent	A large land mass that is usually surrounded by water.
Country	A distinct area of land with its own government and laws.
Equator	An imaginary line that divides the Earth into two hemispheres.
Map	A picture of a place taken from a birds-eye view (above).
Weather	The changeable conditions of the atmosphere at any given time. It might be sunny, hot, windy or rainy.
Physical features	A natural part of the environment not made by humans.
Human features	Things that have been built or made by humans.
