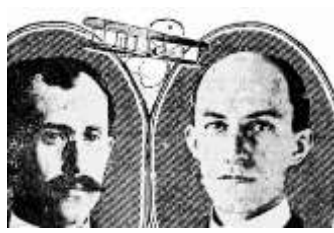

Key Vocabulary	
Evidence	Information which historians take from sources to understand something that happened in the past.
Eyewitness account	A written record or audio recording of someone who witnessed an event
Flight	The action of flying through the air
Historically significant	An important person or event from history.
Inventor	Someone who makes something which has never been made before.
Living memory	Something which happened less than 100 years ago.
Beyond living memory	Something which happened more than 100 years ago.
Primary source	An original document from the historic time which has not been changed in any way.
Timeline	A line showing events in time order.
Achievement	Something done successfully through hard work or courage.
